SECTION 00901 - PROTESTS

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED SECTIONS:

Documents affecting the work of this Section include, but are not necessarily limited to, the General Conditions, the Supplementary Conditions, and other Sections in Division 1 of these Specifications.

1.2 PROTESTS:

- A. Any protest involving the Invitation to Bid must be filed in accordance with, and meet the requirements of, Florida Board of Governors (BOG) Regulation 14.023. Failure to file a notice of protest or the written petition in accordance with BOG Regulation 14.023 shall constitute a waiver of protest proceedings.
- B. At the time of filing the formal written petition, the Vendor shall post with the University of Florida, a bond, payable to the University of Florida, in the amount of \$25,000 or 2% of the lowest accepted bid, whichever is greater, for projects valued over \$500,000; and 5% of the lowest accepted bid for all other projects. The bond shall be conditioned upon payment of all costs and fees which may be adjudged against the Vendor in the administrative hearing. Failure of the Vendor to file the required bond at the time of filing the formal written petition shall result in a denial of the protest.
